• Outstanding Research Project by a student or resident that:

- 1) was initiated by, and/or mainly conducted by the student/resident
- 2) was initiated in 2010/2011 and was, or will be, completed by July 31, 2011
- 3) is in basic science, epidemiology, interventions and/or clinical studies relevant to global health

• Outstanding Community Service Project by a student or resident that:

- 1) was initiated by, and/or mainly conducted by the student/resident
- 2) was initiated in 2010/2011 and was, or will be, completed by July 31, 2011
- 3) addresses the needs of a disadvantaged/underprivileged community(ies) in the Americas or abroad
- 4) had significant impact and will likely continue to have ongoing relevance in the future of the relevant community

To apply for the award funds, applications must include the following items:

- 1) Name of the Lancet - GHEC award being applied for
- 2) Applicant's Name, Title, Institutional Affiliation
- 3) Applicant's Contact information (address, phone, email address)
- 4) A description of the study or the project (500 words maximum)
- 5) Applicant's resume or CV (2 pages maximum, 12 pt. font) - Resume/CV greater than 2 pages will not be reviewed
- 6) A letter of reference from a mentor or supervisor who can provide additional information about the work done and its significance (500 words maximum)

To nominate another for the award funds, nominations must include the following items:

- 1) Name of the Lancet - GHEC award being applied for
- 2) Name of the nominating party
- 3) Contact information for the nominating party (address, phone, email address)
- 4) Nominee's name, title and institutional affiliation
- 5) Contact information for the Nominee
- 6) A description of the research project or community service project (500 words maximum)
- 7) A letter of reference from a mentor or supervisor who can provide additional information about the work done and its significance (500 words maximum)
- 8) The nominee's CV (2 pages maximum, 12 pt. font). CVs greater than 2 pages will not be reviewed.
